Trauma-Informed Mentoring Services

INDIVIDUAL MENTORING

THE INDIVIDUAL MENTORING PROGRAM IS COMMITTED TO MENTORING YOUTH WHO HAVE BEEN IDENTIFIED AS SURVIVORS OF SEXUAL ASSAULT, SEXUAL ABUSE, AND/OR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE. THROUGH HEALTHY, APPROPRIATE RELATIONSHIPS WITH INDIVIDUAL MENTORS, AND STRENGTHS-BASED PROGRAMMING, THE PROGRAM ADDRESSES THE MENTEES' DEVELOPMENTAL, SOCIAL, AND EMOTIONAL NEEDS.

- Individual Mentors work directly with survivors to foster an understanding of their inherent value and innate potential.
- Survivors receive intensive case management for at least one year.

- Individual Mentors provide basic skill development and psychosocial services aimed to reduce survivor's cognitive and behavioral impairments and to restore them to their highest level of functioning.
- Services help recipients acquire constructive cognitive and behavioral skills through
 positive reinforcement, modeling, operant conditioning, and other training techniques.

PARENTING GROUP

THE PARENTING GROUP IS A
TRAUMA-INFORMED SUPPORT/
EDUCATIONAL GROUP FOR ANY
PARENT EXPERIENCING CHALLENGES
WITH ADOLESCENTS. EACH WEEK THE
TEAM WORKS ON DIFFERENT TOPICS,
SUCH AS:

- Identifying parenting styles
- De-escalation
- · Human trafficking
- Attachment and nurturing

GIRLS CIRCLE

GIRLS CIRCLE IS A 12-WEEK STRUCTURED SUPPORT GROUP FOR YOUTH.

SESSIONS ARE LED BY TRAINED FACILITATORS WHO FOCUS ON AREA SUCH AS:

- · self-esteem
- body image
- substance abuse prevention
- anger management
- · anger managemen
- STD prevention
- runaway prevention
- teen homelessness
- dating violence

- violence
- bullying
- · educational success
- career development
- dress for success
- financial literacy
- teen pregnancy prevention

Eligibilty: Girls 12-18 years old from the LV area.

PEER MENTORING

Eligibility: This group is free and open to any parent of an adolescent in the LV area.

UPON SELECTION, YOUTH WILL RECEIVE TRAINING AND PARTICIPATE IN TEAM BUILDING ACTIVITIES TO BECOME A PEER MENTOR.

Eligibility: Successful completion of any TEP program, good attendance and participation.

THE EMBRACING PROJECT'S DROP-IN CENTER IS THE ONLY SPECIALIZED CENTER OF ITS KIND IN THE LAS VEGAS VALLEY. ALL OF OUR SERVICES AND PROGRAMS ARE CLIENT-CENTERED AND TRAUMA-INFORMED. SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Specialized victim-centered advocacy
- Trauma-informed case management
 Transportation
- Crisis intervention
- Support for transitional living
- · Group, individual, and family therapy
- · Vital documentation acquisition
- · Basic needs assistance (i.e. clothing, hygiene, food, healthcare, etc)

- College and Career Readiness and Exploration
- · Referrals to community-based service providers
- · On-site CCSD-approved school
- · Classes on protection from predators, maintaining physical health, and increasing life skills
